
1. Section 4 of the Land Use Permit application has not been filled in, please select the item which applies to your operation;

5. Please submit a forward looking Engagement Plan;
6. Please clarify the refuelling of equipment, (will this take place on site, will there be a fuel truck, will fueling be done from a tidy tank).
