Jen, as we talked about this morning. The above application is deemed a “new application” by the Land and Water Board. There is no mention of any amounts of granular material to be removed. You did say that a person can apply for a land use permit, at the same time apply for a quarrying permit from AANDC. As I mentioned on the call; the procedure that took place in the past, the person had to apply and secure an quarrying permit first, then apply for a land use permit. If successful, you put both permits together, which then allows the applicant to remove material, up to the

specified amount. The problem the NWTMN Lands and Resources Offices(IMA) is having, is in the application provided. There is a letter from Mr. Darrell Dean to Tyree Mullaney of the Land and Water Board dated April 7, 2014. In the letter there are 6 points, in point 1. It states, We have an existing permit in place. Is this existing permit, apart of an old Land Use Permit? This needs to be clarified, before we can comment to the application.
