**Re: Carter Industries Ltd. – 2020 Annual Water Licence Report – Outstanding Submissions
Hay River Soil and Water Treatment Facility – Water Licence MV2016L8-0007**

Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (the Board) staff have identified submissions required by Carter Industries Ltd.'s (Carter's) Water Licence MV2016L8-0007 (Licence) for the Hay River Soil and Water Treatment Facility that have not been submitted as required, and are now late. Board staff suggest these submissions be made as soon as possible.

1. 2020 Annual Water Licence Report

The submission deadline for the 2020 Annual Water Licence Report (Report) was March 31, 2020, as required by Part B, Condition 10 of the Licence, and has not been received by the Board. Staff note the [2018](#) and [2019](#) Reports were also submitted late (on August 5, 2020). The Board's [October 8, 2020](#) letter directed Carter's to address specific recommendations in future Annual Report submissions.

2. Groundwater Monitoring Program, Environmental Protection Plan, and Operations and Maintenance Plan

The Board's [October 8, 2020](#) letter directed Carters to update and resubmit the Groundwater Monitoring Program (Appendix D of the Waste Management Plan), the Environmental Protection Plan, and the Operations and Maintenance Plan, by December 3, 2020. These have not been received.

3. Closure and Reclamation Plan, Version 2.1

On October 9, 2020, the Board provided interim approval of Carter's Interim Closure and Reclamation Plan, Version 2.0, and directed submission of a revised Plan (Version 2.1) by November 5, 2020. This has not been received by the Board.

Apply to Renew the Licence

Staff reminds Carter's that Licence MV2016L8-0007 **expires April 5, 2022**. To operate continually, Carter's is encouraged to begin to prepare and submit a renewal application well in advance of this expiration date. Sections 5 and 6 of the Board's *Guide to the Water Licensing Process*¹ (Guide) contain detailed information on the renewal process. Please reach out to Board staff with any questions while preparing the renewal application package.
