Curtis Duffy and I went out to take a look at the culvert crossing this morning. The culvert itself has approximately only 3 feet until it is entirely closed off. The Inspector feels that if this culvert becomes complete closed off then could result in the redirection of Baker Creek and other major water management risks.

Please provide me with the plan to remove the ice from the culvert once completed. The Inspector would like the plan to try and use heavy equipment as minimally as possible, including no refueling of equipment on or near the ice, and to transport all removed ice to the Northwest Pond.
