**Type A Land Use Permit and Type B Water Licence Applications – Complete
Line 21 Segment Replacement Project, Fort Simpson, NWT**

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received your Applications for a Type B Water Licence (Licence) and Type A Land Use Permit (Permit) on March 23, 2017. Additional information was received through discussions with the Government of the Northwest Territories and with Legal Counsel to clarify eligibility on April 19, 2017. Your Licence Application will be processed in accordance with the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* (MVRMA) and the *Waters Act*. Your Permit Application will be processed in accordance with paragraph 22(1)(b) of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* (MVLUR).

Following review of the Licence Application, the MVLWB will take one of the following actions:

1. Issue a Type B Licence, subject to any conditions included under section 27 of the *Waters Act*;
2. Order that a hearing be held, under section 24 of the MVRMA and/or section 41 of the *Waters Act*;
3. Refer the Application to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board for an environmental assessment under subsection 125(1) of the MVRMA; or
4. Where a requirement set out in section 61 or 62 of the MVRMA has not been met, refuse to issue a Licence.


Following review of the Permit Application, within forty-two (42) days of the date of this letter, the MVLWB will take one of the following actions:

1. Issue a Type A Permit, subject to any conditions included under subsection 26(1) of the MVLUR;
2. Order, under section 24 of the MVRMA, that a hearing be held or further studies or investigations be made respecting the lands proposed to be used in the land-use operation;
3. Refer the Application to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board for an environmental assessment under subsection 125(1) of the Act; or

4. Where a requirement set out in section 61 or 62 of the MVRMA has not been met or for any other reason as provided for in legislation, refuse to issue a permit.
