
**Re: Con Mine – Seasonal discharge of treated effluent ceased 3-July-2024**

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This letter is to provide notice that the seasonal discharge of treated effluent from the Con Mine site utilizing the existing final discharge point SNP 0040-1 and flowing through the Meg, Keg, Peg system to Jackfish Bay on the Great Slave Lake, near Yellowknife, Northwest Territories ceased on July 3, 2024. This concludes the 2024 Seasonal treatment discharge of treated effluent occurred over a period of 31 days beginning on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024. All applicable MDMER, SNP, AEMP and EEM monitoring requirements were completed and will be reported as required.
