Issuance of Quarry Permit at Km 11.3 (R), off NWT Highway No. 4

This letter is to inform you that the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Department of Lands is issuing a quarry permit at Km 11.3 (R), off NWT Highway No. 4.

BACKGROUND

A quarry permit has been applied for at an existing quarry Reserve (R613T) located on Commissioner's Land. The reserve was granted November 2006 and is for stockpile and quarrying purposes which is required for highway operations and maintenance. The applicant is requesting to remove 50,000 cubic metres of blast rock and will be staying within the existing quarry reserve boundaries.
