Hello Scott,

We recently spoke on the phone about eligibility of an applicant (University of Guelph – G360 Institute for Groundwater Research, in collaboration with GNWT-ENR) for a Permit Amendment to drill in the Fort Liard area.

The original Permit was issued in December, 2018, and the attached letter was uploaded during the public review, indicating that the Reserve Holders providing permission to access Lands Reserved for exclusive use by the respective departments resulted in the applicant having the right to occupy under Section 18(b) of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations*.

The amendment UofG applied for includes drilling at Reserve 095B03034, which includes a NorhweSTel lease as well as in the right of way of Highway 7 (see an Updated Project Description [here](#)). You signed a letter that was uploaded to the MVLWB's Online Review System (attached) yesterday that states "Comments received from Territorial Lands Administration indicate no concerns". Can you confirm that this means that the University of Guelph – G360 Institute for Groundwater Monitoring has eligibility under 18(b) of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* to conduct this land use activity?
