In the attached PERVNTRR.jpg is another overhead of our Petitot River site.
The red dots are access points to the fiber optic cable.
The blue dots are the kilometer posts.

As discussed on May 30, 2019:

- please call 888-423-2333 to coordinate a cable locate for all proposed holes to eliminate a fiber strike.
- The only other cables we might have in the area would be associated with the tower and building grounding. This would be more so with Site 2a holes. As I am not sure if these conductors can be “located”, so please hand dig the first 12” of those holes.
- Other than that there was a suggestion that these ground water monitoring stations be marked with a long colored stakes in the ground to eliminate any risks associated with snow removal equipment.

Hi Ronald,

I recently called and chatted with you about a NorthwTel Tower site on Highway 7 (~30 km southeast of Fort Liard). You had been in touch with Anna Coles from GNWT Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) about site access for drilling work for a groundwater monitoring program in the Liard region (see the first attached email conversation from May, 2019). The project is a partnership between GNWT-ENR and the University of Guelph; they had wanted to do the work last July, but are now planning to do the work this coming March. They have applied to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board for an amendment to their Land Use Permit to do the work at the site. The project team has also received permission from GNWT-Infrastructure to drill in a cut-back alongside the highway (see attached email conversation with Dustin from GNWT-Infrastructure).

I am drafting the Land Use Permit for the amendment that includes a number of conditions for the project team to adhere to. I was thinking that I could add a condition to the Permit that requires the project team to contact the appropriate NWTel representative 48 hours prior to commencing drilling. That way your team would know when the work will occur, and can discuss any specific practices that should take place (for example, hand digging the first 6-12", as mentioned in the email). Let me know what you think of this, and if you do agree to this type of condition, if you could provide the position title and contact phone number of the personnel who could be contacted, that would be very helpful.
