Re: Groundwater Monitoring – Land Use Permit – Amendment Request – Incomplete – Fort Liard Region, NT

On March 16, 2023, the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water (Board) staff received the Amendment Request (Request) for Land Use Permit (Permit) MV2018X0017¹ from University of Guelph – G360 Institute for Groundwater Research (G360 Institute).

Board staff have reviewed the Request and identified missing information required for the Board to process the Request. For the Request to be considered complete, refer to the Land and Water Board (LWB) *Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process* (Guide)² and submit the following information to the Board's office:

1. Preliminary Screening: The Request may include changes to the Project, but any changes that are not exempt must be screened and could be subject to an environmental assessment.
 - a. Provide rationale for why some or all of the proposed changes to the Project could be considered exempt from preliminary screening.

2. Engagement Record: Conduct engagement specific to the proposed amendments and in accordance with the Engagement Plan as approved under the Permit. Include the associated Engagement Record in the Request.

Upon receipt of this information, the Board will review the Request in accordance with the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations. This information should be submitted as soon as possible to avoid operational delays. Unless G360 Institute requests additional time, if this information is not provided within 90 days of the date of this letter, the Board will consider the Request withdrawn.
