**Subject:** Notice of Commencement of limited summer program - Courageous Lake

Good day,

Seabridge Gold (NWT) Ltd wishes to inform you that we intend to commence a brief summer field program at our Courageous Lake Property. The field program will consist of limited camp operations, evaluation and mitigation of a known archaeological site near the camp, downloading data and servicing meteorological equipment and wildlife cameras, and minor maintenance of the camp infrastructure as required. There will be no mineral exploration drilling or other activities.

The field activities will be managed by Andrew Gallant and Brandon Potter of *Matrix Camps, Logistics and Aviation Management*.

- A one-day site inspection of the Matthews Lake camp will occur on or about June 18, weather permitting, to determine the condition of the camp and key equipment prior to mobilizing the field crew.
- The Matthews Lake camp will be opened and occupied by about 8-10 people for approximately 7 days, tentatively between July 10 – 17.
- Activities will be supported by both helicopter (*Acasta Heliflight*) and fixed wing aircraft (*Summit Air*). Fixed wing aircraft will use the Tundra/Salmita airstrip.
- At this time, there are no plans to extract any material from the Treeline borrow pit near the camp.

- The camp will have a satellite phone however it will not be monitored 24/7. The personnel conducting this field work will follow the conditions and procedures outlined in our surface lease, land use permit and approved management plans – and they have been provided copies of all relevant documents.
