Re: **Request for Extension to Submission Deadline, Closure and Reclamation Plan  
Prairie Creek Mine All Season Road  
MV/PC2014F0013, MV/PC2014L8-0006**

We refer to the above noted all season road (ASR) permits and a requirement to submit a Closure and Reclamation Plan (CRP) 90 days from issuance of permits.

We further note that Norzinc previously announced that the Canadian Zinc Corporation (CZN) is not able to construction a Phase 1 winter road using the ASR permits over the 2019-2020 winter. Accordingly, we would like to request an extension to the CRP submission deadline since the earliest CZN could contemplate a Phase 1 road is next winter.

In order to allow sufficient time for review and approval of a Phase 1 CRP, we propose a 5 month extension to the submission deadline.
