Parsons, on behalf of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC), for the Giant Mine Remediation Project (GMRP), is notifying the Board and the Land Use Inspector of the following:

On October 25, 2023 Parsons was made aware of potentially contaminated or hazardous waste that was transported off-site on October 19, 2023 to an approved hazardous waste receiver without following the waste manifesting procedures detailed in the Waste MMP.

The exact volumes and types of waste transported to KBL, the hazardous waste receiver were not properly tracked or recorded prior to arrival however current information suggests that it included materials such as waste oil, oily rags, oily debris and contaminated mineral waste (likely soil). Investigations are ongoing to determine the quantity and types of waste that were transported to the facility and if those wastes were properly disposed of as a result of the lack of proper waste documentation. Further information will be provided once it is received.
