Do you know the number of hectares that the rail bed at Pine Point covers? I'm just looking over the fees paid by PPML for the MV2020C0017 Permit Application ([\\$150](#)). As per the [Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations](#), the \$150 Application fee includes the first two hectares, with any additional hectares being \$50.

I just saw a note from Jacqueline that the rail bed is three hectares, so not sure if there should have maybe been an additional \$50 paid.
