Annual Water Report 2022**

As per Schedule 1 of the above-mentioned Water Licence, Paramount Resources Ltd. (Paramount) has listed the information required by the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB) to fulfill the annual report requirements. They are as follows:

- a) An updated as-built was provided in 2020, no changes occurred in 2022. [As built Map](#)
- b) Project activities were limited. Office of the Regulator of Oil and Gas Operations (“OROGO”) inspections took place.
- c) The abandonment activities scheduled took place in the first quarter of 2023. Future activities are expected to be limited to environmental monitoring post Q1 of 2023.
- d) 0m<sup>3</sup>.
- e) Not applicable.
- f) Paramount sent out a notification regarding potential winter activity on October 11, 2022. No responses were received.
- g) Not applicable during the reporting period.
- h) No construction activities occurred during the reporting period.
- i) No major maintenance occurred during reporting period.
