**Land Use Permit MV2020P0006**

Please be advised that pursuant to Condition 6 of Land Use Permit MV2020P0006, Enbridge pipelines Operations intends to commence winter work activities on the 15th January 2021. Our planned winter work program in the Dehcho area will include: Propane refills at sites KP's 276, 305, 440, 452, 465, 529, we will be constructing temporary roads and doing minor brushing in conjunction with the road construction. Brushing will be completed between KP's 440 and 465 as well as 529 to 550. Instrument installs will take place on slopes at KP 270 (whitesands) slopes on both sides as well as KP 311 and 318 roads will be put to these sites also.

As you are aware, will have an integrity dig program this season working in the Wrigley area utilizing a camp at the KP 325 site as in the past. Digs will take place at the following locations KP 265, 267, 299.4 and 5, 316, 330, 335.6

This work may entail Dozers or snow cats, Grader, water trucks, Back hoe's, Hydrovac, steam truck and loaders, tractor and lowboy, pickup truck support vehicles. Small sized drill unit and accompanying support vehicles 1 cube van and 1 drop deck transport truck, mulchers.

Work will adhere to conditions stipulated within the land use permit.

Should we require any additional contract equipment we will update you.
