Good afternoon Matt et al,

Further to our meeting last Friday and as requested, I'm writing to voice my concerns regarding the proximity of the new water intake site to the Float Plane dock and vehicle turnaround/landing, and

the potential for contamination of the intake if a fuel spill were to occur.

In order to avoid potential contamination, is it possible for NTPC to move the water intake site back further from the waterline, dock and landing? If not, is it possible to relocate the dock and route vehicle traffic further away from the intake? Please let me know if either of these options are feasible.

Regardless, NTPC will need to be more vigilant about spills and spill prevention in this area. It's recommended that an additional spill kit be placed down near the new intake, and that the Spill Contingency plan be updated to reflect any new mitigating measures that will be implemented as a result of this change.
