Hello Andy,

Apologies for the delay I was on leave the end of last week.

The attached *NTPC Taltson River Work Camp- Sediment and Erosion Control Management Plan* is for the construction of the staff accommodation facilities (including operation of some of the borrow locations) that is taking place in the summer of 2020. This is one of the first projects required in the Taltson Overhaul project and one of 16 phases planned for 2020-2024 outlined in the *Taltson Hydro - Construction of Replacement Facilities and Overhaul- Construction, Wildlife Management and Reclamation Plan*.

The majority of the 2020 camp construction work is further than 100 meters from the ordinary high-water mark of the Taltson forebay but the edges of the work area are within the 100m mark. The clay borrow locations are within 100 meters of the ordinary high-water mark as well. As discussed below and in previous correspondence the construction of the staff accommodation facilities is planned to begin this week.

The attached *NTPC Taltson River Work Camp- Sediment and Erosion Control Management Plan* is intended as a submission for Board approval under Condition 19 of the Permit but given the project timelines it will not be able to undergo the 60 day review process as the installation of the camp would not be possible in 2020 with a 60 day delay and this would delay all future work planned as part of Taltson Overhaul by a full year. The Taltson unit is the sole provider of power to the South Slave Region and the overhaul of the unit is required to ensure reliable power for the area.

For future submissions under Condition 19 of the Permit NTPC will ensure Sediment and Erosion Control Management Plans are submitted 60 days prior to earthworks.

Hello Andy, Shannon and Leslie

Thank you for your support throughout the application and review process. We have reviewed the permit and wanted to provide a few updates:

- Waste Facility Upgrades discussed in previous correspondence were completed last week and included erosion and sediment control measures
 - Updated Standard Operating Procedures for waste sorting at the site including photos will be provided asap
- Wildlife surveys for the replacement camp area and borrow locations are scheduled for next week
- We are currently developing an Earthworks Regulatory Requirements Plan which will be provided to any contractors completing earthworks to provide further clarity on the conditions and requirements that have been approved within the licence. The plan will include:

- Quarry permit requirements and required reporting
- Information on avoiding wildlife features (bank swallow nests, raptor nests etc.)
- Proper vegetation and topsoil removal and disposal techniques
- An erosion and sediment control plan for the replacement camp construction and all quarries
- As discussed in previous correspondence earthworks is scheduled to begin on July 13, 2020

This Earthworks Regulatory Requirements Plan will be focused on the project phases occurring this summer. The Earthworks Regulatory Requirements Plan will be submitted to the inspectors and MVLWB for comment but will not be able to go through the public review and approval process without delaying the camp construction (and all other projects that depend on it) by a year.

A more detail Sediment and Erosion Plan for earthworks across the whole site will be developed and submitted to the MVLWB with the updated Waste and Spill Plans prior to 2021 construction with enough time to go through the public review and approval process.

Leslie, Please consider this as the formal notification that we plan to beginning work under the permit on July 13, 2020. Please keep me posted on your planned inspection dates and if there is there is any other info I can provide at this point.
