Hello Shannon, Andy, Leslie and Rob,

Please accept this email as the seasonal notification for the start of work under the Taltson Overhaul - Type A Land Use Permit- MV2020X0004 and GNWT Quarry Permit 2020QP0019.

The installation of the temporary water line will begin on Thursday April 29, 2021. No major earthworks are planned until June 1, 2021.

To account for reduced capacity in the existing camp due to COVID restrictions 8 temporary beds will be placed in 4 prospector tents on NTPC owned land adjacent to the existing camp. These tents will use the washroom facilities for the existing camp and be in place until September/October 2021.
