On behalf of the Naha Dehe Dene Band (NDDDB), I am submitting the following comment on the work plan regarding the Prairie Creek - Mining and Milling - New Type A Land Use Permit and Water Licence Renewal Applications (MV2021D0005 MV2021L2-0004).

Comment: NDDDB staff have reviewed the work plan MVLWB circulated for comment, and CZN's proposed revisions which aim for a Water Board decision to be sent to the Minister in late March 2022. NDDDB staff can confirm that they will strive to work within the timelines proposed in NorZinc's revised schedule. If NDDDB deems that extensions to the work plan are required due to emergent issues, NDDDB will advise the MVLWB.

Recommendation: MVLWB consider the revised workplan proposed by CZN on June 15.
