Hi Kim,

We have only had the chance to do a high level review of the IRs. From this initial review, it does not appear necessary to have public review at this time, however we won't be able to say with certainty until we have completed our review.

Given the amount of information provided in the Information Requests, and some potential proposed changes to some aspects of the project (e.g., length of the exfiltration trench, water management), we are requesting a two week extension to the Intervention deadline from October 8 to October 22. Because of the Thanksgiving long weekend occurring during these two weeks, this will amount to 9 working days. We feel that this time is necessary to properly analyse the Information Requests to inform recommendations put forward in the Intervention.
