Thanks for your response to Erica's question about notification with respect to using the municipal landfill. It sounds like you are having a successful year – good to hear business is thriving and tourism is rebounding post the pandemic.

To reiterate what Erica said, as per Part F, Condition 5 of your [Water License](#), Great Slave Lake Lodge is required to provide written notification to the Board and Inspector of deposit of Waste into a licensed municipal facility for the calendar year a minimum of 10 days prior to first deposit.

For this year, I will receive your email below as the required notification. In future years, please send notification as per the condition listed above.

Thanks in anticipation for your cooperation and compliance. If you have any questions about this condition or other aspects of your water license, please don't hesitate to contact me.

I hope what is left of the season goes well for you.

Good morning Chuk and Reid,

I hope that you've had a successful operating season – it sure seems like there are a lot of fishers wandering around Yellowknife these days.

I was asked recently to look at a few examples of outfitters receiving permission from municipalities for waste disposal, and in looking through your new licence, realized that your condition related to this needs attention. Part F, Condition 5 of the [Licence](#) requires GSSL to provide written notification, to the Board and Inspector, of deposit of Waste into a licensed municipal facility for the calendar year, a minimum of 10 days prior to first deposit. The Board's Reasons for Decision (page 41/44 in the same linked document) explain further:

Applicants (other than municipalities) planning to deposit Waste at municipal facilities must obtain written agreement from the municipality in advance and should submit it with their application. However, applicants should note that the ability of the municipality to accept and manage additional Waste streams may change over time, so applicants should develop contingencies as part of their Waste Management Plan. The intent of this Condition is to

allow the Inspector an opportunity to confirm that the licenced municipal facility is still able to accept the Waste as originally proposed. This condition includes a timeline and frequency of notification that is Project-specific; the Board received no comments on this condition during the public review of the draft Licence conditions.

I understand that you're probably still busy with operations, but if you haven't already taken waste into the City landfill, my guess is that you will need to soon. Please make sure to send the notification to both myself and Meg (copied here). Please also don't hesitate to get in touch if you have any questions about this requirement.
