Re: City of Yellowknife – Land Use Permit – Final Plan Request – Geotechnical Drilling– Yellowknife, NT

According to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (Board) records, Land Use Permit MV2022S0011 (Permit) for the Yellowknife Pumphouse Geotechnical Drilling program will expire on October 25, 2024.

Should additional time be required to complete the Project, refer to subsection 26(6) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR), and the Land and Water Board (LWB) *Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process*,¹ for more information on extensions to land use permits. A request for an extension of not more than two years must be received by the Board prior to the expiry date of the Permit. Alternatively, if the Board does not receive an extension request, then site restoration, clean up, and removal of equipment, materials, buildings, etc. must be completed before the Permit expires.

A final plan must be submitted to the Board within 60 days after either the expiry of the Permit or the end of the Project (whichever comes first), as per section 29 of the MVLUR. The final plan must include:

1. A map, normally at a scale of 1:50,000, showing the location, area, and distances of all Project activities. All maps must have the north indicator, scale, and coordinates clearly marked;
2. GIS data, if available; and
3. A summary of the hectares utilized in each aspect of the Project.
