RE: Your letter dated July 13, 2022: Wildlife Act Section 95(1) Determination of the Requirement for a Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan for Digaa Enterprises Ltd. Timber Harvesting

Digaa Enterprises Ltd. (Digaa), was issued a Forest Management Agreement (FMA) in 2014. The FMA contains a vision statement from the Office of the Premier, regarding the importance of the Digaa Forest Management Agreement to the Community of Fort Providence.

'The GNWT wants communities to benefit from the forests, create economic investment opportunities for the forest industry and increase environmental stewardship and sustainability of forests in the NWT.'
(*'Digaa FMA, Plain English' version, 2014*).

Digaa was issued Land Use Permit MV2022W0006 in 2022 to conduct timber harvesting operations in its FMA areas, on the south side of the MacKenzie River.

Digaa hereby submits its Tier 1 Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan (WMMP), as a requirement to meet the direction provided by your Office (July 13, 2022).

Digaa has initiated consultations of its WMMP with the "Affected Parties", per the 'Engagement Plan', that is contained within our Land Use Permit.
