Good Morning,

Thanks for the call this morning. As mentioned as of today, we have completed the main access road preparation going from the highway to the H-03 camp (~ 40 km). We are now continuing to work on the accesses going to the three well cut and caps north of the H-03 camp. The well sites we are accessing for cut & caps include, J-04, I-10 and L-29 (previous gas migrations issues). The well cut & caps should be completed sometime in the first or second week of February. We will let you know once we have a firm date nailed down for the cut & caps. Next, we will be accessing the pipeline riser sites located at the two ATV bridges located near C-50 and A-73. Rowe's Construction out of Hay River is doing the access preparation for us this winter. Right now, they are utilizing 2 graders, 2 snow cats, 5 water trucks and a dozer. Access to M-31 was completed by Pinnacle on January 20th. Pinnacle was already doing the access for Conoco's 2-31 well (~5 km from M-31) so it made sense to use them for the M-31 portion. We must measure the frost depth at a couple of the water crossings to ensure the road is sufficient for a service rig. The plan is to bring in a service rig on February 1st.

The camp (Torch camp and old operators camp) has been up and running for just over a week now. There have been no issues, and everything is running smoothly. That is about all to report this week. If you have any questions or concerns, please let me know.
