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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Prestige Lithium Inc. (Prestige). is advancing the Prestige Project (the Project). The Project will include ongoing surficial geological investigations and drilling. This Engagement Plan describes how Prestige will engage with affected parties prior to commencing work and once work is underway.

1.2 Project Description

Prestige Lithium is planning the Prestige Lithium Project to further investigate lithium deposits within the Mineral Claim areas. The Project will include continued surface geological mapping, channel and rock sampling, and a small drill program. It is anticipated that drilling will occur in up to eight locations during the fall of 2023, using one drill. Drilling is anticipated to require two to four weeks to complete, starting after July and ending before November. The drill will be transported to the drill sites by helicopter. Clearing of vegetation may be required on drill pads. Water for drilling will be drawn from local water sources. Water use will be below 99 cubic meters per day, so a water licence is not required. Project staff during drilling will include up to six people, working two 12 hr shifts and returning to camp. Additional drilling may occur in future years.
