Good morning,

Thank you for your email and review of Liard First Nation's (LFN's) Request for Ruling for Intervener status. LFN has reviewed the responses from the Public Registry and thanks those who took the time to respond.

With the Board's decision to cancel the Public Hearing for the MV2023L2-0006 application, it is unclear how LFN's status as an intervener poses a qualitative difference to the application process. This may now be a moot point. Should the Board decide a future Hearing is necessary, LFN will want to participate as an intervener. As it stands, LFN can and will continue participating in the review and comment of materials via the Public Registry and Online Review System as an active Party to the Process.

LFN notes two recommendations made to the MVLWB from Naha Dehe Dene Band (NDDDB). LFN appreciates the shared concern and perspective on recognizing Indigenous water users. LFN supports NDDDB's recommendation to acknowledge this in the Board's Reasons for Decision and to update future licences and permits to reflect use of the land and water by local Indigenous groups. LFN also supports NDDDB's second recommendation that LFN's Request for Ruling not add time to the latest workplan. LFN supports an effective decision by the Board that will allow for closure and maintenance activities to continue at the Cantung site during the ongoing regulatory process.
