**Re: JD Contracting – Land Use Permit – New Application – Incomplete – Quarrying – Km 41.5, NWT Highway 5, NT**

On February 21, 2023, Mackenzie Valley Land and Water (Board) staff received the Application Package (Application) for a new Land Use Permit (Permit) MV2023Q0007<sup>1</sup> for the Km 41.5 NWT Highway 5 Quarry project (Project) from JD Contracting.

Board staff have reviewed the Application and identified missing information required for the Board to process the Application. For the Application to be considered complete, refer to the Application Form<sup>2</sup> and the Land and Water Boards' *Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process* (Guide)<sup>3</sup> and submit the following information to the Board's office:

1. Proof of Registration: Provide a copy of the current Certificate of Corporate Registration from the Government of the Northwest Territories.
2. Geographic Coordinates: On the Application Form, revise geographic coordinates (latitude and longitude) for the maximum and minimum Project boundary. The coordinates provided in the application form do not cover the entire project area.

3. Engagement Record and Plan: Conduct engagement specific to the Application. Include an Engagement Record and Engagement Plan in the Application. Please refer to the [MVLWB Engagement Guidelines for Applicants and Holders of Water Licences and Land Use Permits \(2018\)](#).
4. Eligibility: The application's completeness will not be affected with the provided Quarry Permit Application acknowledgement letter from GNWT-Lands, however, an issued GNWT-Lands Quarry Permit must be submitted to the Board before this Land Use Permit can be Issued.
5. Application Fee: Submit the \$150.00 application fee payable to the Receiver General for Canada to the Board office.

Upon receipt of this information, the Board will review the Application in accordance with the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR). Unless JD Contracting requests additional time, if this information is not provided within 90 days of the date of this letter, the Board will consider the Application withdrawn.
