**Issuance of a Quarry Permit at Km 44.5, NWT Highway No. 5 - Site HR34-5**

This letter is to inform you that the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Department of Environment and Climate Change is issuing a quarry permit at Km 44.5, NWT Highway No. 5 - Site HR34-5.

**BACKGROUND**

Hay River Disposals (1985) Ltd. have applied for a 3-year quarry permit to remove 7,000 cubic metres of gravel for on-going commercial projects. The last quarrying permit that the company was granted has expired and to continue with their projects they require more gravel material. It is important to note that the quarry boundaries identified in their application are the same boundaries previously applied for and are not proposed to change.
