1 Introduction

The Government of the Northwest Territories Department of Infrastructure (GNWT-INF) is advancing the Lockhart All Season Road (LASR), which will consist of an all-season road extending from Tibbitt Lake to Lockhart Lake, replacing part of the existing Tibbitt to Contwoyto Winter Road.

This Engagement Plan describes how and when GNWT-INF will engage with Affected Parties, including contact information, engagement triggers and means of communication.

1.2 Project Description

The Government of the Northwest Territories - Department of Infrastructure (GNWT-INF) is proposing to conduct Geotechnical Investigations to gather information in support the development of the Lockhart All Season Road (LASR) between Highway 4 (the Ingraham Trail) at Tibbitt Lake to Lockhart Lake. The Geotechnical Investigations will consist of assessing potential hard-rock quarries and granular resources (collectively referred to as target areas) as material for construction of an all-season road.

Potential target areas that have been identified for further investigation between Highway 4 and Lockhart Lake from desktop evaluation and previous studies are provided in Appendix A. Additional potential target areas may be identified based on on-going engagement and studies.

Project operations that occur in the summer will include the use of heli-portable drills and will use existing camps in the area. No new roads or trails are required.

Project operations occurring in the winter will include the use of heli-portable drills and the construction of spur roads from the Tibbitt to Contwoyto Winter Road for the Project. Work will be supported by existing camps or by the creation of a mobile camp. Generally, hard-rock quarries will be assessed by drill, while granular resources will be sampled by digging test pits. The assessment of each target area will include describing geochemistry, volumes, subgrade conditions, drainage and ground temperature. Monitoring equipment may be installed (e.g., such as ground temperature

monitors) and may include monuments or other surface infrastructure. The development of fuel caches may be required to support testing pitting and drilling operations.

1.3 Engagement Goals

The goals of engagement are to:

- Confirm that existing land users and claimants to the land are aware of regulatory applications.
- Explain the LASR and its components, including development activities and timing.
- Explain the geotechnical investigations required as part of the LASR.
- Facilitate timely access to the LASR information.
- Identify concerns and how they can be jointly resolved.
- Incorporate engagement feedback, including Indigenous Knowledge (IK) into planning and regulatory process.
- Identify opportunities for employment and contracting opportunities.
- Strive to build and maintain positive long-term relationships.

1.4 Indigenous Knowledge

The GNWT-INF recognizes that the Indigenous Peoples of the NWT have unique knowledge about the local environment through their long and close relationship with the land. Indigenous Knowledge will play an important role in planning, construction and monitoring of the LASR. Working collaboratively with Indigenous communities and their governments to integrate Indigenous Knowledge in process can help to identify effects and associated mitigation measures.

2 Potentially Affected Parties

The Engagement Guidelines (LWB 2023) recommends that “*proponents focus their engagement efforts towards parties that will likely be the most directly impacted.*” This is done to focus engagement activities on those with the greatest interest and to avoid consultation fatigue. 3 Engagement Methods

GNWT-INF will employ several methods to engage potentially affected parties depending on the nature and/or urgency of the information to be communicated. Methods that may be employed are summarized below.

3.1 Presentations

Presentations provide the best opportunity for communication and dialogue. The use of visual aids can make meetings effective. Presentations may be held with a specific group or organization, or the public as a whole. Translators will be provided where necessary. The advantage of public meetings is that participants all hear the same information and may benefit from participating in discussions including various organizations or perspectives. As presentations require more resources, planning, and time commitments by all parties, their application should reflect the importance of the issue.

3.2 Teleconferences

Teleconferences with affected parties are an efficient method of communicating information quickly and receiving feedback. Teleconferences can be organized to engage more than one party in the discussion, enabling a variety of perspectives to be presented and discussed collectively.

3.3 Workshops

Workshops may be used when information needs to be shared with a large number of people or if technical issues arise that require a deep understanding from affected parties. For workshops to be successful, translators will be provided where necessary. Key deliverables available to workshop

participants include agendas, meeting notes, participant lists, presentation materials, lists of action items, and follow-up materials or commitments.

3.4 Letters

Electronic mail will be used to contact parties to provide information, arrange for teleconferences or meetings, or for routine communications. When electronic mail is not available or easily accessible by affected parties, letters delivered by post may be used.

3.5 Public Communication

In addition to the specific engagement methods for Affected Parties described above, GNWT-INF will continue efforts to communicate details about LASR to the public. A public service announcement and project backgrounder, as well as updates to social media on GNWT-INF Twitter and Facebook accounts, will be issued publicly when engagement for this project starts. As well, a project-specific webpage on the GNWT’s online ‘Have Your Say’ engagement portal (<https://haveyoursay.nwt-tno.ca>) will be created and be publicly available during the engagement period. Media releases, fact sheets and social media may also be issued to announce significant milestones, communicate upcoming activities or in response to events. 4.2 Engagement Record and Issues Management

A summary of all engagement undertaken based on the engagement triggers described in Table 2 will be provided in the Engagement Record (Appendix A).

For engagement to be successful, parties must have an opportunity to be informed, provide feedback, and be confident that their input is being considered. This requires that issues raised by parties are documented, tracked, and responded to. The GNWT-INF will manage issues raised during engagement by documenting the issues raised during engagement, GNWT-INF response to the issues, and how the issue will be jointly resolved by all concerned.
