**Re: Stark Lake Remediation Project Type A Land Use Permit Application**

Dear Tyree Mullaney,

Please see attached application and supporting documentation for a Type A Land Use Permit for the Stark Lake Remediation Project, respectfully submitted by Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada – Contaminants and Remediation Division (CIRNAC-CARD).

All assessment work has now been completed for the Stark Lake project, with the Closure and Reclamation Plan having been finalized after input from Łutsël K'é Dene First Nation (LKDFN). The full scale remediation work is scheduled to begin in July 2024 and be completed by March 30, 2025.

The work required to complete remediation triggers a Type A Land Use Permit but not a Water Licence. Our application describes this more fully.

CIRNAC-CARD is requesting a five (5) year Type A Land Use Permit. These authorizations will allow for the completion of remediation activities and the commencement of Long Term Monitoring for the Stark Lake project site.
