Subject: Phase 1 ASR Construction - Licence Requirements

Hi Claudine,

CZN has indicated their intent in the near future to begin constructing the ice bridge across the Liard River as part of Phase 1 construction. As a reminder, watercourse crossings, including ice bridges, are scoped under the ASR Licences [MV2014L8-0006](#) and [MV2019L8-0002](#), which have conditions that require Board approval of management plans prior to the commencement of Phase 1 activities. The authorizations issued by Parks Canada Agency have the same requirements.

In October 2021, CZN submitted various management plans that require Board approval prior to the commencement of Phase 1 activities, however, to date the following management plans have not been fully approved by the Board:

- Waste Management Plan
- Sediment and Erosion Control Plan
- Permafrost Management and Monitoring Plan
- Geochemical Verification Program
- Water Monitoring Plan
- Spill Contingency Plan (pending conformity of Parks Canada's requirements)
- Avalanche Hazard Management Plan
- Rare Plant Management Plan
- Invasive Species Management Plan
- Traffic Control Plan
- Cultural Heritage Protection Plan

Further, in accordance with condition B.22 of the Licences CZN must:

A minimum of ten days prior to commencement of the Project including Phases 1, 2, and 3, the Licensee shall provide written notification to the Board and an Inspector. Notification shall include the commencement date, and the name and contact information of the Licensee's Field Supervisor. Any updates shall be provided to the Board and an Inspector in writing as changes occur.
