**Explanatory Remarks:**

The unacceptable condition regarding Matters not Inconsistent is the **Final Plans** condition. This condition states, "The Permittee shall submit a Final Plan in Digital Format compatible with ARC GIS software for the footprint used and a map at a scale of 1:250,000 for the operation". The Sahtu Land and Water Board has not received any final plans from Eagle Plains Resources Ltd.

There was a letter dated September 04, 2014, addressed to Steve Deschene (Resource Management Officer) From Eagle Plains Resources Ltd discussing both this permit and S07C-006. The letter describes the work completed by Eagle Plains Resources, and this is a notice of closure for Land Use Permit S07C-006. Unfortunately, this is not the process of how Land Use Permits are closed. The method of closing a Land Use permit consists of an Inspector deeming all permitted conditions are met once the Permittee claims all work and

remediation has been completed. When the final inspection is complete, the Inspector will recommend file closure if no further remediation is required. The Sahtu Land and Water Board will commence file closure when they receive the final plans from the Permittee. Therefore, until the Inspector recommends the file for file closure and final plans are received, this permit cannot be closed.

Furthermore, in regards to the letter addressed to Mr. Deschene, it is said there was an agreement with Stanley Stevens (Ram Head Outfitters) to stage the drums at his loading dock until Northwright Airways can backhaul and truck the empties South. Mr. Stevens owns and operates Mackenzie Mountain Outfitters at Willowhandle Lake; Ram Head Outfitters was owned and operated by Stanley Simpson. As seen in the figures below, there still are drums from this project on the airstrip and floatplane loading area. Until Eagle Plains resources can produce the written agreement from both Mr. Stevens and Northwright Airways, Eagle Plains Resources Ltd is still liable for the fuel drums.

If Eagle Plains Resources can produce the documentation of both agreements, and submit the final plans, The Inspector will recommend this file for file closure.
