**Re: Deline Water Licence S12L3-006
Revised Landfill and Sewage Lagoon Closure and Reclamation Plan
Board Approval – Addendum Pending**

On September 26, 2014, the Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB) received the Revised Closure and Reclamation Plan for decommissioning of the Deline Landfill and Sewage Lagoon, submitted by the Government of Northwest Territories Department of Municipal and Community Affairs (MACA) on behalf of the Charter Community of Deline, in collaboration with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR). After careful review, on March 5, 2015 the Board approved the submitted CRP contingent on the provision of the additional commitments outlined in MACA's response to the review agency comments, received by the Board on February 4, 2015. The approval of the CRP is to facilitate the capability to move forward with the process to implement the remediation and closure activities.

To fulfill the conditions of the Water Licence (Part G, Item 1 and 4) the Board requests that the Community of Deline, MACA and ENR submit to the Board by July 31, 2015:

1. Implementation Schedule outlining the work plan and timeline to initiating remediation process;
2. CRP Addendum addressing concerns raised during the review process; and
3. Detailed time schedule for completion of remediation activities outlined in Section 8 of the Revised CRP.

It has also been noted by Board Staff that As-built drawings for the Solid Waste Facility, which we understand construction has been complete, have not been received within the 90 day period as specified in Part H, Item 3 of the Licence. We request that this information be forwarded as soon as possible to meet the conditions of the Licence.
