### **Demco Fuel Cache Removal Time Line**

July 15, 2020 – In talks with Plummer's Lodge Great Bear Lake to determine if they might be interested in 131 drums of fuel stored at the Terra mine site air strip at the Demco Fuel Cache location. Plummer's expressed interest and arrangements made to confirm timing of removal. This deemed the most environmentally friendly and cost effect way to remove this fuel.

July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020 - Plummer's mobilized crew and Turbo Otter to Great Bear Lake Lodge and plan on checking site for float access and requirements to access fuel.

July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 - Site was checked and there were no issues to access the fuel cache location and staging of float plane Turbo Otter. Fuel shuttles are expected to begin to relocate fuel, berm and miscellaneous garbage back to the 2 locations of Plummer's Lodge on Great Bear Lake.

July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 – One hundred drums were moved from the fuel cache over this time to Plummer's sites at this time.

August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020 – All fuels, berm and misc. garbage removed from the Terra mine site fuel cache.
