Good Afternoon Diane,

As you know, during the recent Operations Committee meetings, we explained the status of the Land Use Permit (LUP), and here is a quick summary:

- LUP expired in July 2022
- Maintaining the LUP is critical to ensure that CIRNAC can:
 - o conduct care and maintenance activities,
 - o respond to potential environmental instability
 - o prepare sites for remediation
- LUP extension request was submitted to the Sahtu Land and Water Board in July, but the processing of the request is on-hold until CIRNAC and Délı̄nę were able to speak about the extension request during the recent Operations Committee Meeting.


We are pleased that during the Operations Committee Meeting on Nov 8, 2022, that a motion was passed unanimously to proceed with the Land Use Permit extension process with the SLWB.

As per the committee's decision, CIRNAC will inform the SLWB to proceed with the Land Use Permit extension.
