**Re: Crown Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada – Contaminants and Remediation Division  
- Request for Final Plan – Land Use Permit S17D-003 – Mining Exploration – Mine Shaft – Great Bear  
Lake, NT**

According to the Sahtu Land and Water Board (Board) records, Land Use Permit S17D-003 (Permit) for the Great Bear Lake Remediation Project (Project) will expire on July 24, 2022.

Should additional time be required to complete the Project, please refer to subsection 26(6) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR), and the Board's *Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process*,<sup>1</sup> for more information on extensions to land use permits. A request for an extension of not more than two (2) years must be received by the Board prior to the expiry date of the Permit. Alternatively, if you do not wish to proceed with an extension request, then site restoration, clean up, and removal of equipment, materials, buildings, etc. must be completed before the Permit expires.

A final plan must be submitted to the Board within sixty (60) days of the expiry of the Permit, as per section 29 of the MVLUR. The final plan must include:

1. A map, normally at a scale of 1:50,000, showing the location, area, and distances of all Project activities. Sketches may be acceptable, but all maps must have the north indicator, scale, and coordinates clearly marked;
2. A summary of the hectares utilized in each aspect of the Project; and
