The Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB or the Board) met on April 19, 2018 to consider the documents submitted on February 5, 2018 as required in the December 5, 2017 issuance letter for Licence S17L8-003 and Permit S17X-004. In accordance with S17L8-003, the Board required the following submissions:

- Spill Contingency Plan, Version 2.0, which was submitted to fulfill Part H, Condition 2;
- Waste Management Plan, Version 2.0, which was submitted to fulfill Part E, Condition 4; and
- Land Treatment Unit (Landfarm) Operation and Maintenance Manual, which was submitted to fulfill Part E, Condition 6.

The Introduction section of the Spill Contingency and Waste Management Plans includes a summary of revisions, in accordance with Part B, condition 4 of the Licence. The Plans had been considered Version 1.2 when submitted however in consideration of the scope of changes are now considered Version 2.0.

The Board hereby approves the Spill Contingency Plan, Version 2.0 as submitted.

The Board hereby approves the Waste Management Plan, Version 2.0 as submitted.

The Board hereby approves the Land Treatment Unit Operation and Maintenance Manual, Version 1.0 as submitted.

A copy of these Plans have been filed on the Public Registry at the office of the SLWB. Please be advised that this letter, all Inspection Reports, and correspondence related thereto is part of the Public Registry and is intended to keep all interested parties informed of the manner in which the Licence's requirements are being met. All Public Registry material will be considered if an amendment to the Licence is requested.
