Hello again Valene,

Please view the following web-link for [Deline Municipal Solid Waste Drawings](#) where there are designated areas for the batteries, oil (hazardous waste), and wood (bulk waste) at the newly constructed site. This document is from Deline's old Municipal Licence [S12L3-006](#). Please have a look at page 2 of the document, Phase III of the construction.

Please let us know if DGG (Deline Gotine Govt) used the same drawings for constructing the solid waste site.

If DGG has used the same drawings for the newly constructed site (without modifications), the document can be accepted under the File [S18L3-001](#) as "Final Design Drawing" as per Part E, item 4 of the Water Licence. Once this is done, batteries, oil, and wood can be deposited at designated areas, after the site inspection by Inspector.

We would like to know what you meant by saying " we need to create new sites for the batteries, oil and wood at the new solid waste site", does that mean a) the construction of hazardous waste area and bulk waste area has not started, and a separate location/design is required for the same or b) the construction of hazardous waste area and bulk waste area has not started, and the location and design is as per the [Deline Municipal Solid Waste Drawings](#) as per [S12L3-006](#).

If your answer is "a" (as given above), the licensee will have to apply (to SLWB) to amend the licence S18L3-001 accordingly. If your answer is "b", then the licensee can go ahead and submit the final drawings ([Deline Municipal Solid Waste Drawings](#)), complete the construction of new site, submit the updated O & M Plan, submit the As-built plan, get the site inspected by the Inspector and finally use the site for depositing batteries, oil, wood, and other solid wastes.

Please answer the underlined question. It will help both sides (DGG and SLWB) to know how to proceed with Deline's new solid waste site.

Hello Valene,

Thank you for your e-mail.

Deline's Municipal [Water Licence S18L3-001](#) (licence terms and conditions) covers both the Solid Waste Disposal Facility (the new one – noted to be under construction) and the Temporary Solid Waste Disposal Facility.

The license gives the following definition (under Part A: Scope and Definitions) for “Solid Waste Disposal Facilities”:
The area and associated structures that are under construction and designed to contain solid wastes as described in the [Application](#) and identified in the Facility Locations Map dated March 9, 2018.

Water Licence Part D, item 4 requires the licensee to submit to SLWB for approval, an Operation and Maintenance Plan for the Solid Waste Disposal Facility (updated O and M plan for the new facility). As-built report for the same will be required as per Part E, item 6 of the licence. Inspection of the facility is required by Part D, item 10 of the licence.

In short, the Licence authorizes the new solid waste disposal facility location and construction.

Good Morning Valene,

Re New Solid Waste Site construction, DGG needs to contact SLWB. Construction of New Solid Waste Site is not covered by current water licence of DGG.

Please see attached documents that were sent to DGG by SLWB for compliance (Page 11 of 22, Part E: Conditions Applying to Construction).

As detailed in Part E: Conditions Applying to Construction: you need to engage Professional Engineer for design, supervision, inspection, and the requirement of 'As-built Report and As-built Drawings to be stamped and signed by a Professional Engineer for the New Solid Waste Site (See Serial No. 2 and Serial No. 6 and all other conditions for 'Applying to Construction' and 'Construction Plans and As-built Reports').

These are the conditions of SLWB and you need to contact SLWB if you need any clarifications. Re your question 'We have to create a site beside the new solid waste site for the: batteries, oil and wood pile. What are the requirements for each', your consultant's engineer knows what are the requirements. They will design, stamp and sign the engineered drawings as required by SLWB.

Any work related to construction of New Solid Waste Site is GTF eligible. If you use own resources, pre-approval from GNWT is required (please see attached 'GTF Eligible Categories Information Sheet: Page 2 of 3: Serial No. 1.2' and 'Own Resources Request Form' for pre-approval).

As discussed over the phone, I am sending you the web-links from SLWB Registry File of Water Licence [S18L3-001](#), for the relevant documents to the Water Licence solid waste disposal at Deline. This Licence was issued on April 19, 2018 (Valid from May 5, 2018 until May 4, 2023), in response to the Water Licence renewal application submitted by the Déljñę Got'jñę Government (DGG), for Deline's use of water and disposal of waste for municipal purposes including:

- water treatment and use from Great Bear Lake for community use
- solid waste disposal – currently at a temporary Solid Waste Facility (SWF), to be moved to a new SWF in 2018
- sewage disposal – at the new lagoon facility commissioned in 2016
- closure and reclamation – of the temporary SWF and the old sewage lagoon in 2019
