RE: Installation of new groundwater monitoring wells at the Norman Wells Airport – Application for a Land Use Permit

Transport Canada plans to install two groundwater monitoring wells at the Norman Wells Airport as part of the department's ongoing monitoring program at the airport. Installation of new monitoring wells will occur in previously disturbed areas and will require the use of power-driven, earth-drilling machinery. All work will occur within the airport property boundary, which is zoned for industrial use.

Installation is scheduled October 2018, once all permits are received. A map indicating the approximate location of proposed monitoring wells is attached for your reference.
