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1 INTRODUCTION

- a) A summary of engagement activities conducted in accordance with the approved Engagement Plan, in Part B, condition 17 of this Licence, undertaken during the previous calendar year and shall include a brief description of activities planned for the forthcoming year.
- b) A summary of Construction activities conducted in accordance with Part E of this Licence, undertaken during the previous year calendar year.
- c) A summary of modifications and/or major maintenance work carried out on the water supply facilities, sewage disposal facilities, and solid waste disposal facilities, including all associated structures.
- d) A summary of activities conducted in accordance with the approved Waste Management Plan, required in Part H, condition 2 of this Licence, undertaken during the previous calendar year.

All affected parties (Délįnę Got'ine Government) were contacted throughout the season and the engagements can be referenced in the engagement log. No major questions or concerns were noted by any of the affected parties about the water licence. Before the commencement of the upcoming 2024 season, an update will be sent to the Délįnę Got'ine Government including notification of the upcoming season as well as job postings.

Great Bear Lake Lodge starting in the Spring of 2021 has been trying, and to date, unsuccessfully coordinate a Traditional Knowledge Study for the Great Bear Lake Lodge area to be completed with the Délįnę Got'ine Government before the Water Licence renewal in 2024. Great Bear Lake Lodge will continue to communicate with representatives from Délįnę to have one completed.

There were no construction activities during the 2023 operating season.
