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Good afternoon Chris.

I am writing to provide you ten days' notice of Enbridge's planned completion of the project at KP158 on the Little Smith Creek road as required in condition 8 of our Land use Permit S20P-003.

- a. The drill is complete, the existing line tied in and all the old pipe has been removed from the original ditchline. The operations crews plan on starting the line tomorrow and then Line 21 will be back in full service. All construction equipment, materials and camp trailers are now being removed and we anticipate being fully moved out by March 15th
- b. Final cleanup and reclamation is in progress and will be complete by March 15th
- c. Final plan (report and pictures) will be submitted once we are fully demobilized from the site (tentatively scheduled for March 15, 2021)

Erin, we don't have any plans to use any more water but we will keep the water source open until the bulk of the equipment and loads are removed in case we need any water to repair the ice road. I will let you know when the water location has been closed and all hoses and signs removed.

Please let me know if there is any more information you require.

- 8. At least ten days prior to the completion of the land-use operation, the Permittee shall advise an Inspector of:**

 - a) the plan for removal or storage of equipment and materials;
 - b) when final cleanup and reclamation of the land used will be completed; and
 - c) when the Final Plan will be submitted.
