We have reviewed the MVH AOA report and have requested minor revisions. We'll issue an acceptance letter with full recommendations once we receive the final AOA.

The proposed project activities (as described under S20S-002) will result in minimal ground disturbance within the existing winter RoW. The project area has also been subject to a previous AIA Study under NWT Archaeological Permit 2015-002. No further work is necessary, providing drill activities are restricted to the existing RoW.

I've spoken to Bonnie Bergsma (SLWB) who has said this email will suffice as approval of the proposed activities and I have cc'd her here.

Hi Naomi,

The only drilling that we will be doing this winter along the stretch of land covered by this AOA is right at the 12 Mile Creek Bridge.

The bridge is (hence its name) about 12 miles south of Tulita. We want to drill 2 holes off each end of the bridge. The drilling will be right on the existing alignment w(i.e. n the winter road driving surface) with no new land disturbance.

I don't need you to review this whole AOA report right now. If you could just get us a letter to clear us to drill on the current alignment at 12 Mile Creek Bridge, that is all I need so I can give that to the SLWB.
