

Traditional Name: Little Bear River Quarry

Sahtu Land Use Zone: Special Management Zone 63 (Deh Cho)

Prohibited Uses: Bulk Water Removal

Quarrying is permitted provided that it adheres to Conformity Requirements (CR) #2-#14. The details of these CR can be found in Section 3.3 of the *Final Sahtu Land Use Plan*. The table below provides a brief description of the relevant CR and how the proposed quarry meets these requirements.

Conformity Requirement #	Description	Explanation of How Proposed Quarry Adheres to Relevant CR
CR #2	Community Engagement and Traditional Knowledge	Community organizations have been engaged and made aware of proposed location, scope, and nature of activities. See Engagement Plan for more details.
CR #3	Community Benefits	Quarry is in the public interest. It allows the Hamlet of Tulita to develop and maintain public infrastructure for the residents in the Hamlet.
CR #4	Archaeological Sites and Burial Sites	There are no known archaeological or burial sites within 500m of the quarry or access road.
CR #5	Watershed Management	Quarry does not substantially alter quality, quantity, or rate of flow for waters that flow on, through, or are adjacent to Sahtu lands. See Spill Contingency Plan and Waste Management Plan for more details.
CR #6	Drinking Water	Quarry will not contaminate surface or groundwater within community catchments. See Spill Contingency Plan and Waste Management Plan for more details.
CR #7	Fish and Wildlife	No significant impact to wildlife, habitat, migration patterns, and important community harvesting areas.
CR #8	Species Introductions	No introduction of non-native plant or animal species are proposed.
CR #9	Sensitive Species and Features	There are no known sensitive species and features within 1000 m of quarry or access road.
CR #10	Permafrost	Activities will only take place in winter on frozen ground.
CR #11	Project-Specific Monitoring	Monitoring will take place throughout project in conformity with Sahtu Land and Water Board land use permit requirements.
CR #12	Financial Security	The Hamlet of Tulita will post financial security if required by the Sahtu Land and Water Board.
CR #13	Closure and Reclamation	Closure and reclamation not required for this activity.
CR #14	Protection of Special Values	Activities will be designed and carried out in a manner that protects, respects or takes into account the values of the zone.
