Good Evening Margaret,

I hope this email finds you well! It has been about a month since my last visit to the Sahtu region, and I would like to provide some updates and requests as we move forward into the summer season.

Updates

- Our company's fundraising campaign is underway, and while the capital markets have been a challenge lately, we still aim to raise enough funds to perform exploration activities on the KAP project this summer.
- The documents pertaining to the Land Use Permit (LUP) for drilling activities have been prepared and are ready for submission to begin public review. The LUP is planned to be submitted to the SLWB on Monday, and notification is anticipated in mid-July.
- A professional archaeologist has been contracted to conduct a desktop Archaeological Overview Assessment (AOA) of archaeological and historical data, and an analysis of the physical attributes of the project area. This information will be used in conjunction with a Traditional Knowledge (TK) study to identify where archaeological sites are expected to be located. The AOA results are expected by the end of May.
- A professional geologist has been contracted to conduct an orientation study on the project, to validate the geochemistry of previously identified mineral showings, and to confirm past drill collar locations. The work is planned for mid-May.
- A soil geochemistry program is being developed to help identify areas of potential mineralization. The work plan is under development, and tentatively planned for mid-July.
- A diamond drill program is being developed to test known areas of mineralization, and to test areas of geochemistry and geophysical anomalies. The work plan is under development, and tentatively planned for August.

Requests

- I would like to commence a TK study for the project as it pertains to the project area, including community benefits, archaeological sites, wildlife, and the environment. Please provide a date and time that works for a virtual meeting or phone call to discuss next steps forward.
- As work plan developments are underway, I would like to be able to plan to include local equipment and personnel where possible. If available to your group, please provide a list or database of contractors that are available to support exploration activities.
