Hello Jessica, Anneli and David,

NTPC is planning on completing the Snare Cascades- Dyke Wall Raising Project beginning in early July 2021. This work was recommended in the 2011 Snare Dam Safety Review and has been referenced or included in several Snare Dam Safety submissions since 2011. The most recent submission is from August 2020 and is attached for review.

Some details for the scope of work for the project are provided in the attached document. This work will be completed as a modification as per *PART D: Conditions Applying to Modifications* in the Snare Cascades-DPC - Type A Water Licence - W2014L4-0001. The approved Spill Contingency and Waste Management Plans under W2014L4-0001 will apply to this scope of work but will not require any project specific updates.

The 500m<sup>3</sup> rockfill may be deferred to 2022 but NTPC would like to completed this work in 2021 if possible. No quarrying will take place as part of the project as all rock and gravel for concrete are part of existing NTPC stockpiles.
