**Re: Water Use Fees Confirmation of Payment**

All licensees are required to pay water use fees, except for the federal government, territorial government, and municipalities, in accordance with Sections 7 and 95 of the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* (MVRMA). These fees are calculated in accordance with Section 9 of the *Northwest Territories Waters Regulations* and the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board's [Water use Fee Policy](#).

Based on the [water use fee calculator](#), the annual water use fee for Dogrib Power Corporation's (DPC) W2014L4-0001 Water Licence is \$1,500.00. The water use fees must be paid at the time of issuance and annually for the duration of the licence, on or before its anniversary date of September 5. **Please confirm DPC's payment of water use fees for the period of September 5, 2014 to September 5, 2015 (i.e., 1x \$1,500).**

For water use on non-federal land, please make cheques payable to the Government of the Northwest Territories, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, #600, 5102 50<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Yellowknife NT, X1A 3S8 and please continue to submit fees to the WLWB with a cover letter attached.
