**RE: Final Plan Request - Mineral Exploration at Hepburn Lake, NT**

Based on our land use records, Land Use Permit W2015C0002 expires on March 25, 2022. Pursuant to subsection 26(6) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR), no further extensions of this Permit can be considered. Restoration, as well as clean up and removal of equipment, materials, building, ext., must be completed.

Pursuant to section 29 of the MVLUR, Adamera Minerals Corp. (Adamera) is now required to submit a final plan. As described in section 5.4 of the MVLWB Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process, the Final Plan is to include the following content:

1. A map or sketch, normally at a scale of 1:50,000, showing the location, the area, and distances of all project activities, including:
  - Lines, trails, rights-of-way, and cleared areas that were used by the permittee during the project, specifically those that were cleared by the permittee and those that existed before the project began;
  - Buildings, structures, campsites, landing strips, aircraft navigation aids, fuel and supply storage sites, waste disposal sites, excavations, and other works and places that were constructed or used by the permittee for the project; and
  - Bridges, dams, ditches, railroads, roads, transmission lines, pipelines, survey lines, monuments, air landing strips, watercourses, traplines and cabins, and all other features or works that were affected by the project.
2. GIS data;
3. A summary of the hectares utilized in each aspect of the land use operation; and
4. A calculation of land use fees.

Should Adamera wish to continue its land use operations, it may apply for a new land use permit, pursuant to section 19 of the MVLUR. If Adamera would like to apply for a new permit, please submit the permit application a minimum of 60 days prior to the expiry of Land Use Permit W2015C0002. Please refer to the Boards' Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process when preparing the application and contact Board staff with any questions. As per the Boards' Engagement and Consultation Policy, Adamera must conduct pre-

submission engagement prior to submitting a land use permit application. Please refer to the Boards' Engagement Guidelines for Applicants and Holders of Water Licences and Land Use Permits for information and guidance on pre-submission engagement. As per section 3.1 of the Boards' Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process, engagement should be initiated well in advance of the submission of the application.
