### Engagement Plan

Effective February 25, 2015

#### Introduction

GGL Resources Corp. ("GGL" or the "Company") intends to advance its exploration efforts on the CH Project ("CH" or the "Project"). The Company commits to actively engage with the Tłı̄cho Government, NWT Treaty 8 Tribal Corporation – Akaitcho Interim Measures Agreement Implementation Office, Kitikmeot Inuit Association, North Slave Métis Alliance (NSMA) and the Wek'èezhii Renewable Resources Board. In addition, the Company will conduct ongoing engagement and communications with Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC), GNWT and the Wek'èezhii Land and Water Board (the "Board").

The Company will also engage with any interested nearby communities, regulatory agencies and Non-Government Organizations (NGO's) in order to both provide awareness and address concerns raised as a result of our exploration activities.

The Company has applied for a Land Use Permit, which will be in effect for a five year period, commencing in 2015, with a possible two year extension. Current activities are being conducted under the auspices of Land Use Permit W2008C0004.

Engagement for Land Use Permit W2008C0004 has included Indian & Northern Affairs Canada (INAC, now AANDC), the Tłı̄cho Government, NWT Treaty 8 Tribal Corporation – Akaitcho Interim Measures Agreement Implementation Office, Kitikmeot Inuit Association, North Slave Métis Alliance (NSMA) and the Wek'èezhii Renewable Resources Board, The NWT Treat 8 Tribal

Corporation represent the Akaitcho Dene First Nation groups: Yellowknives Dene First Nation; Lutsel K'e Dene First Nation; Deninu Kue Dene First Nation; Dettah First Nation; and Ndilo First Nation .

GGL's project at CH is currently in the early exploration stage. Promising samples obtained by prospecting and encouraging geophysical targets from airborne and ground geophysical surveys are evidence that economic mineral potential may exist in the CH Project area. This Engagement Plan is intended to provide a means for open communications and sharing of information with interested parties as the project advances. In the event that the project scope changes in any significant way, GGL would re-evaluate the existing plan to discuss the changes and then work towards development of a more comprehensive Engagement Plan.

### Engagement Plan

The CH Project is being conducted on both Tłı̄cho and Akaitcho Dene lands. Developing open and transparent communications during the life of the permit will provide more clarity and assistance for the process of engaging all parties. GGL recognizes that the different parties will need different methods of engagement based upon their communications requirements.

Engagement of affected parties and the public in general will help build co-operative working relationships and support for the Project. It will also serve to bring forward important issues, minimize delays due to any possible opposition, and allow GGL to become better informed on issues affecting First Nations people of the region and the sensitivity of land use operations.

Communications were provided by the Company (one copy of notification letter attached) by mail and/or email and/or fax during the period prior to application for the Land Use Permit. The Company has offered to answer any questions or concerns by any of the affected organizations or groups by phone, email and/or fax as part of the Engagement Plan.

Recent exploration activity on the Project has comprised geological mapping, prospecting, ground geophysical surveys and diamond drilling. The ground geophysical surveys were being used to follow-up anomalies from a prior airborne survey. Diamond drilling has been utilized to drill exploration targets from these geophysical surveys. These activities have been conducted from GGL's Zip Camp (Land Use Permit W2008C0001).

The benefits of the Engagement Plan apply to both the proponent (GGL) and potentially impacted parties. The Plan will provide structured dialogue for communications with the various governments and organizations which may be impacted throughout the life of the project. The Plan encompassed in this document will define the ongoing commitment of GGL to the various groups. All exploration activities and especially anything that changes the scope of the current project will be discussed before, during and after with the affected groups.

The formal engagement and communication process will consist of:

- Communications that ensure adequate time for sharing information and review.
- Open two-way communications with aboriginal governments and organizations in order to share information and maintain an open dialogue.
- The use of plain language when describing the technical aspects of the program.
- Implementation of the Engagement Plan with follow-up reporting and review.

Types of engagement which may be conducted under the auspices of the Engagement Plan can consist of:

1. In Person Meetings.
2. Electronic Mail (email).
3. Fact Sheets.
4. Community Meetings.

In Person Meetings will allow for direct discussion of specific issues, initiatives and the addressing of any concerns. Email will allow GGL to communicate with affected parties and obtain their input in order to address Project related issues. Fact Sheets will provide clarity of information in plain language in order to reduce public concerns. Community Meetings would be established in order to allow the public to hear relevant Project information with an opportunity to ask questions and make comments. GGL's goal is to provide firsthand information, engagement and involvement.

If GGL finds itself in a situation where there is limited or no activity, there will be much less engagement as there will be little news to share. Any change in the scope of activity would be communicated directly to the affected parties and recommendations sought on how to engage related groups with ongoing communications. This will allow GGL to maintain effective two-way communications with affected parties, establish constructive dialogue and ultimately provide benefit to GGL and all affected parties.
