I've reviewed your Operational Notification dated March 9th, 2024 regarding the temporary placement of kimberlite ore at the A21 West Ramp Load Out Pile. It appears the operation complies with the DDMI *Waste Rock Management Plan* and with the operating conditions annexed to Water Licence W2015L2-0001 (Part G, Condition #7).
